JSSATEN WOMEN'S CELL ACTIVITIES

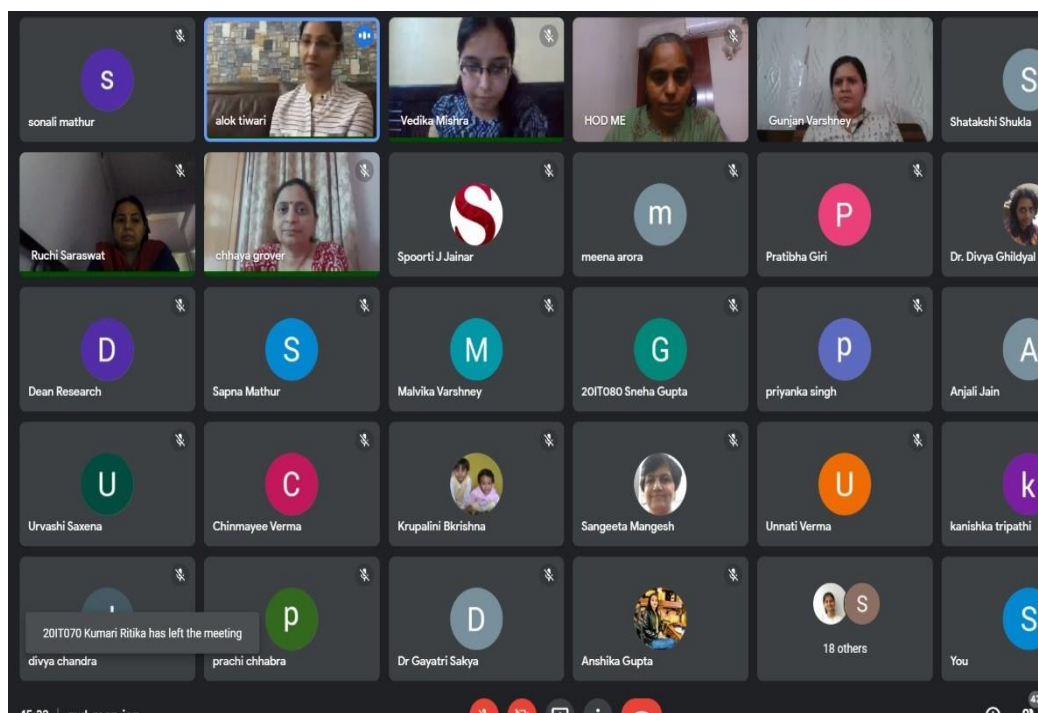
Activities for AY 2021-22:

- A guest lecture (online) on topic “WOMEN SAFETY MEASURES” was organized by JSS Academy of Technical Education Noida- Women Cell on 19th November ‘2020. The expert talk was delivered by Professor Rakhi Tripathi, Fore School of Management, New Delhi. Prof. Rakhi Tripathi is currently Associate professor, Dept. Of Information Technology, Fore School of Management, New Delhi. She is also Head of the Centre for Digital Innovation at Fore. She is an M.S (CS) from Bowie State University, University of Maryland System, USA. She has completed her Ph.D. from IIT, Delhi. Professor Rakhi Tripathi discussed about the women safety, self-independence and empowerment. She focussed on ways to ensure Women’s safety. She urged women to practice self-defence techniques. She stated that all acts of aggression towards women are tools to assert power over a woman, be it rape, molestation or even 'eve-teasing'. She discussed some quick-fixes that woman can keep handy. She also discussed the pros and cons of ‘Me Too” movement. She shared some safety apps like “HIMMAT” and “SAFETIPIN” which make public spaces safer, more inclusive for women. She concluded the change in society and intervention by authorities will take time, it's best to stay alert and prepared by ourselves. The lecture on “Women Safety Measures” was attended by Dr. R.S. 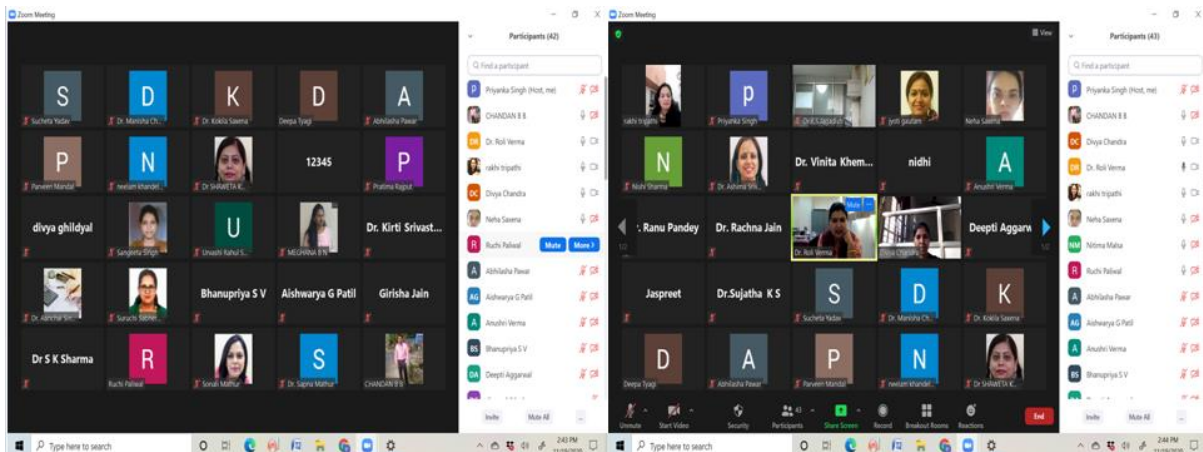

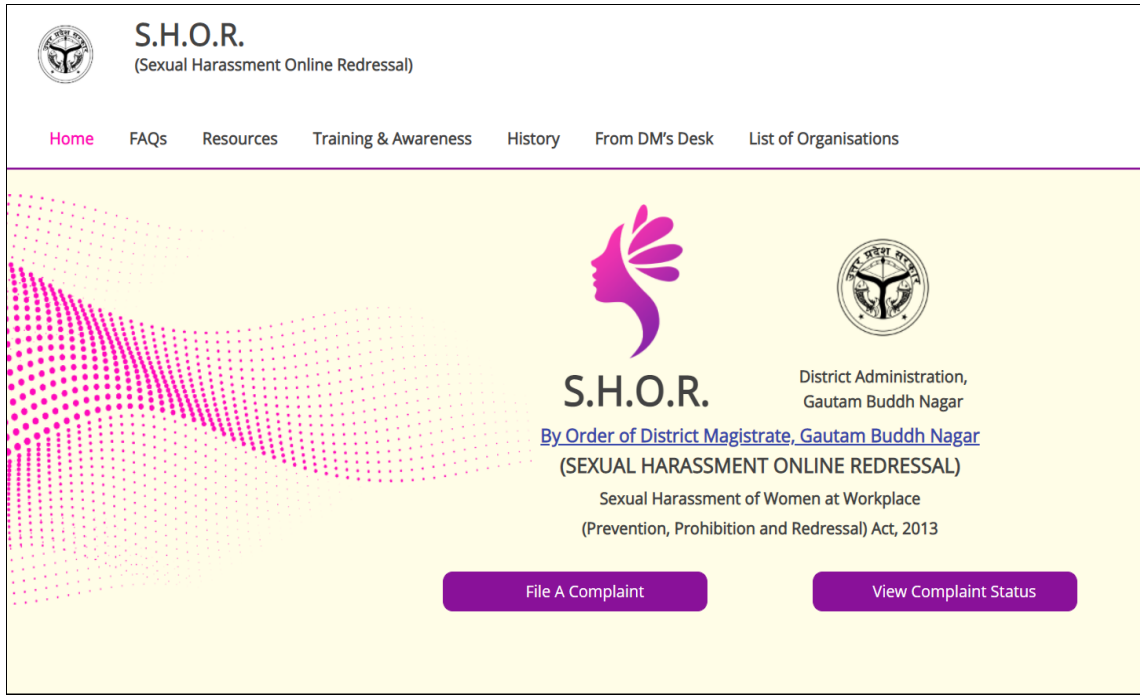
